Drug Bags

PCEMS has purchased new drug bags for all squads. All paramedic and advanced drugs are in this one bag. The advanced pouch carries all advanced drugs, these advanced drugs will no longer be in the paramedic pouch. The paramedic pouch will only carry paramedic drugs. Example D50... There are 2 D50s in the advanced pouch and none in the paramedic pouch. When opening/untagging a drug pouch you will need to fill out the sticker book in the side pouch of the drug bag. You will need to fill out 2 numbers for the pouch you opened (old #, new #) and also need to write down the numbers on the other pouches. The pouch labeled supplies has 2 nebulizers, syringes and needles for drawing up meds.

Basic Drugs

Basic drugs that were attached to the heart monitor by a pencil pouch are now located in the zipper pouch to the right of the heart monitor. These also have a tag on them and will need to be written down on the notebook inside the pouch.
